"There are many children our son's age and older and it is a vibrant and friendly community. We enjoy play dates with our son and other families in the community."

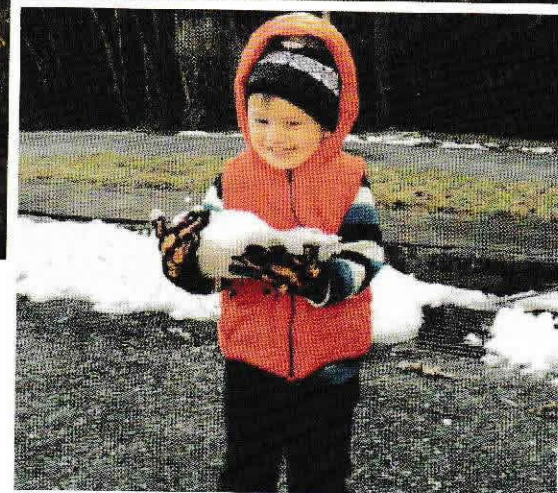
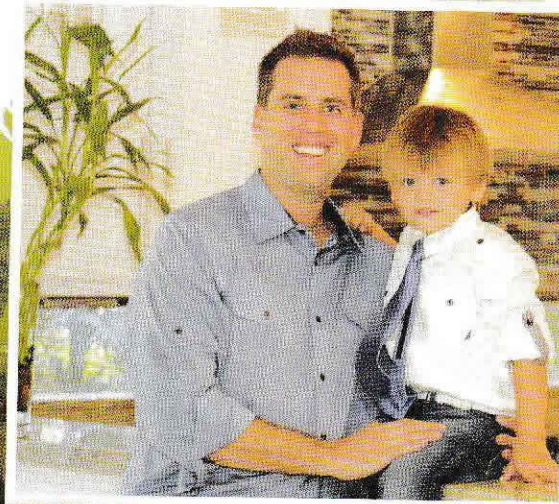
Dr. Gorscak focuses on refractive cataract surgery, glaucoma, and comprehensive eye care.
